



1. Separate hair at the temple straight back and clip up. Place headband over top with the front resting on your forehead .



2. Release the clip letting the hair fall over the band . Separate the entire Mohawk section and clip out of the way leaving an inch and a half of loose hair above AND below the elastic just on the sides .



3. Gather a section from each side of the elastic and split into 3 equal parts . Begin French braiding towards the back pulling your pieces from either side of the elastic as to make sure the band is hidden. Repeat on the other side section as well.



4. Thoroughly tease the entire crown section of your Mohawk (Like , rockstar , 80's style)



5. Begin your faux hawk French braid from the top. Braiding loosely as to not flatten your large and in charge tease job!



6. Continue the faux hawk French braid until it meets at the base with your two side braids , when you reach them , simply pull them into the finishing braid .



7. NOW, you can choose to leave the braid down and loose.



8. But with the length of my hair, I choose to roll the braid up underneath my hair and pin it into place.
